With single-desk selling, worldwide market information allows the CWB to price differently into different markets in order to maximize returns to farmers.

Important note to voters:

CWB elections utilize a “preferential ballot,” which allows you to vote for more than one candidate. We encourage you to put a ranking number beside each and every Pro-CWB candidate who supports a strong CWB single-desk. Do not place a number beside any candidate who is not Pro-CWB.
